

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

(I) Senior Members: Senior members shall be at least eighteen (18) years of age. This class shall be further subdivided into Senior Eligible, Senior Ineligible, and Senior Restricted. The Senior Eligible member, in addition to the privileges authorized by the USFSA Bylaws, shall have the right to vote, hold office be eligible for stipends if representing the Club in competitions, and shall enjoy all the privileges of the Club In accordance with the USFSA Bylaws. The Senior Ineligible Member has the right to vote, but may not hold office. One Senior Ineligible Member may be a Director with a vote on the Board of Directors. The Senior Restricted Member has a vote, but may not hold office, or be a Director.

(II) Junior with Parent: Junior members shall be under the age of eighteen (18) years of age and hold no vote, may not hold office or be a director. One parent that is at least eighteen (18) years of age must join with their junior member and has a right to vote, hold office and shall enjoy all the privileges of the Club. The Junior member shall be eligible for stipends if representing the Club in competition.

(III) Family Membership: This membership category is the best category for families with more than one skater at the same address. Members in this category receive privileges authorized by the USFSA Bylaws. Each family member is registered with the USFSA and will receive a USFSA number; your skating family members can take USFSA tests, compete in USFSA competitions and take part in all carnivals and exhibitions hosted by the club. Each family will have one (1) vote (must be 18 years of age or older to vote) at SFSCNC general membership meetings.

(IV) Associate Members: Associate members shall have no voting rights and shall be ineligible for stipends. They shall be able to test at the Senior Member rate with no additional charge. They may skate in all carnivals and exhibitions hosted by the Club. During contracted ice time, if they skate, they may be required to pay an additional fee as set forth by the Board of Directors.

(V) Honorary Members: Persons may be invited by the Board of Directors to become an Honorary Member of SFSCNC after a recommendation is presented by any board member to the Board of Directors, and all proper procedures used in voting shall determine the outcome. An honorary member(s) shall be free from initiation fees, dues and/or assessments. They may represent the Club at exhibitions and attend ice skating sessions under the same rules governing active members. They shall not be nominated or elected as an Officer or Director on the Board of Directors, but may be appointed by the Board to fill a vacancy. Honorary members shall have voting rights. They shall have no claim on the assets or property of the Club. They shall not represent the Club in competitions.

(VI) Coaches: Coaches shall have the right to vote, hold office, and enjoy all the privileges of the Club in accordance with the USFSA Bylaws.
